



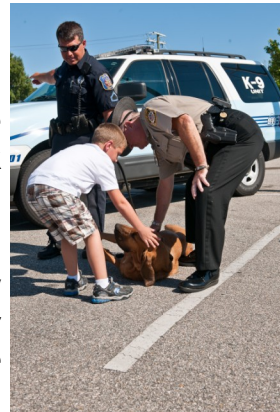
Neighborhood Night Out - September 17th

Ride the BID Bus to the Chili Cook-Off



On Saturday, October 1, the **Five Alarm Festival & Chili Cook-Off** returns to downtown Hampton, complete with food vendors, fire safety demonstrations, children's activities, exhibitors, and more.

The event, taking place 12-4PM at Carousel Park (adjacent to the Virginia Air & Space Center), will officially kick off National Fire Prevention Month and provide valuable fire and life safety information for festival attendees in a fun and delicious atmosphere.

The cook-off will last until 2:30PM. Festival attendees can purchase cups of chili for \$1.00 or samples for \$.50. Other activities for this year's festival include a K-9 accelerant demonstration and rappelling. Children will want to take a ride on the inflatable slide and stop by booth for face painting. There will also be craft tents sponsored Home Depot and Lowes. All of the activities are free of charge.

Marys Park Dedication

Peninsula Town Center will pay tribute to all area teachers by officially dedicating one of its two parks in honor of four renowned female educators on Saturday, September 17th at 11AM.

Marys Park (across from Macy's) commemorates educators Mary Johnson, Mary Passage, Mary Christian and Mary Peake. The **Marys Park dedication** will take place on the 150th anniversary of Mary Peake's historic instruction of the children of former slaves who sought refuge at Fort Monroe. In addition to the unveiling of a sign commemorating the four Marys, Peninsula historian John Quarstein will speak about the historical significance of the day; Mary Christian, the lone surviving Mary, and Hampton Mayor Molly Ward will offer remarks and the band from Mary Passage Middle School will perform.



All guests will receive a VIP passport for discounts to stores at Peninsula Town Center. Throughout that weekend, any public or private school teacher who brings identification of where he or she works will also receive the passport.
